

PROHIBITED ITEMS

LV GOLF SECURITY AND SAFETY POLICY

PROHIBITED ITEMS include, but are not limited to:



Firearms, knives, electronic "blow" devices, chemicals, or other weapons of any kind (regardless of license or permit).



Lounge chairs, oversized chairs with extendable footrests or rigid type chairs such as solid metal lawn or folding chairs. Chairs and/or seat cushions must not be stored in a bag. Special club programs are permissible.



Briefcases, toolboxes, toolpods of any kind, or other hard-sided bags or containers.



Coolers of any kind, unless medically necessary.



Glass containers of any kind, unless medically necessary. Any refillable liquid container larger than 11.5L/32 oz. Any refillable liquid container that is not empty or factory sealed.



Anything (including but not limited to, flags, items, banners, shirts, etc.) that would facilitate around marketing or other commercial activity. No banners, balloons, symbols, items, clothing, signage, or propaganda permitted at an event unless it is a member of the organization or consulting an event to welcome.



Golf clubs of any type, brooms, poles, telescopes, staves, or sticks. Golf shoes with metal spikes.



Video cameras or other equipment designed for the sole purpose of video and/or audio recording, except for credit/informational purposes.



Animals (except service animals to all guests with disabilities).



Alcohol and illegal drugs or recreational drugs of any kind.



Air horns, fireworks, confetti, streamers, flares, and other celebratory devices that may interfere with or distract an event participant or impede audio or audiovisual broadcast or recording of the event, or any technology-related service provided at the Tournament.



TV's, computers, laptops, or tablets to include wireless devices that emit radio waves such as all phone applications, mobile navigation and wireless, Wi-Fi routers (wireless local networking devices), except for personal mobile phones and wireless receivers (such as radios).



Step ladders, stools, buckets, milk crates, or raised platforms of any kind.



Proteins (e.g., golf balls, Frisbees, or disc golf).



Drones, remote-controlled aircraft, or other unmanned devices.




Aerosol cans (e.g., mace, pepper spray, hairspray, or sunscreen). Cream sunscreen is allowed.



No bicycles, segways, scooters, skateboards, or other personal transportation devices (motor or self-propelled) allowed through all meaning gates (other than used for individuals with mobility disabilities or medical purposes).

ENTRY & CARRY-IN POLICY



Guests are permitted to carry an opaque bag, measuring no larger than 6" x 6" x 6" (small sized handbag) and/or a duffel bag no larger than 12" x 6" x 32" (20.5 cm x 15.25 cm x 30.5 cm), in their natural state such as a Ziploc® or freezer bag. There will be no storage or collection for oversized bags.

No bottles, garments, hardware or other objects are considered any part of the bag. Guests may carry loose in the tournament for individual use in their resealable plastic bag not to exceed the size of a (golf) bag. Aerials, goggles, pears and other whole fruit must be out in half. Outside beverages are not permitted.

One reusable plastic or metal water cup/bottle per person that is empty or factory sealed, which cannot hold more than 32oz./1L is allowed.

Exceptions are made for Guests with medical needs and for glass baby bottles at the sole and absolute discretion of management.

Bags and other items will be inspected by security personnel at screening table. Guests' belongings within 10 feet of the table at the screening process, and Guests can pick up their belongings at the end of the table once they have completed the inspection.

Medically necessary materials, mobility assistive devices, strollers, and small diaper bags are allowed and are subject to search.

Any items that could affect the safety of the Tournament, its attendees, or property shall not be permitted onto the grounds. Any person that could affect the safety of the Tournament, its attendees, or property will be denied entry.

LV Golf management reserves the right to prohibit or require the removal of any items at its sole and absolute discretion.



Objects that might compromise or disrupt the experience and enjoyment of other spectators, such as large flags, banners, signs, oversized hats, large umbrellas, golf umbrellas, blowers, whistles, water balloons, musical instruments, horns, etc.



Visibly obscene, indecent, or inappropriate clothing, masks, or costumes.



Small pocket-sized digital cameras with a zoom lens 4 inches or shorter (any pocket-sized larger 35mm camera cannot exceed 1 inches in length).



Large camera pens, video stills, movie tripods, or other professional camera equipment.



Any other objects deemed dangerous or inappropriate at the sole discretion of LV Golf or its representatives that might compromise or disrupt the experience and enjoyment of other spectators, or the safety of LV Golf sponsors or endorsed activity.
