PROHIBITED ITEMS

PROHIBITED ITEMS include, but are not limited to:



Firearms, knives, electronic "stun" devices, chemicals, or other weapons of any kind (regardless of license or permit).



No bicycles, segways, scooters, skateboards, or other personal transportation devices (motorized or self-propelled) allowed inside admission gates (other than used for individuals with mobility disabilities or medical purposes).



Drones, remote-controlled aircraft, or other unmanned devices.



Anything (including but not limited to, flags, flyers, banners, clothing etc.) that would facilitate ambush marketing or other commercial activity. No banners, boards, symbols, flyers, clothing, insignias, or propaganda-type material of an extreme religious, racist, or xenophobic nature or constituting an incitement to violence.



Alcohol and illegal drugs or recreational drugs of any kind.



TV's, computers, laptops, or tablets to include wireless devices that emit radio waves (such as cell phone signal jammers, radio scanners and walkie talkies, wi-fi routers (wireless local networking devices), except for personal mobile phones and wireless receivers (such as radios).

BAG POLICY



Guests are permitted to carry a clear bag in its natural state, such as a Ziploc gallon freezer bag, and/or an opaque bag. There will be no storage offered for oversized bags.

FOOD POLICY

Guests may bring food into the tournament for individual consumption in a clear, resealable plastic bag not to exceed the size of a (1) gallon bag.

Apples, oranges, pears and other whole fruit must be cut in half.

One reusable metal plastic water cup/bottle per person that is empty or factory sealed, which cannot hold more than 32 oz / 1 L is allowed.

LOST & FOUND



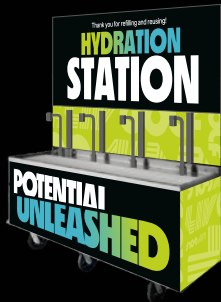
Lost & Found is in Fan Services Tent located near the 3rd tee box.

OFFICIAL MERCHANDISE



Official Merchandise is located near the driving range across from the 3rd Hole. Opening hours are from gates open until gates close – estimated to be 30 minutes after the concert on Friday and Saturday and 30 minutes after the Podium Ceremony on Sunday.

HYDRATION



Water bottle refill stations are available throughout the course. Bring your own water bottle to stay hydrated and avoid single use plastics.

Guests may bring one reusable metal or plastic water cup or bottle, no bigger than 32 oz or 1 liter, which must be empty upon entry and exit.

FAMILY SERVICES & ACCESSIBILITY



RTJ Club has continuous cart paths to provide easy access for those in wheelchairs. ADA viewing areas are available at the 1st Tee, 9th Green, and 18th Green.

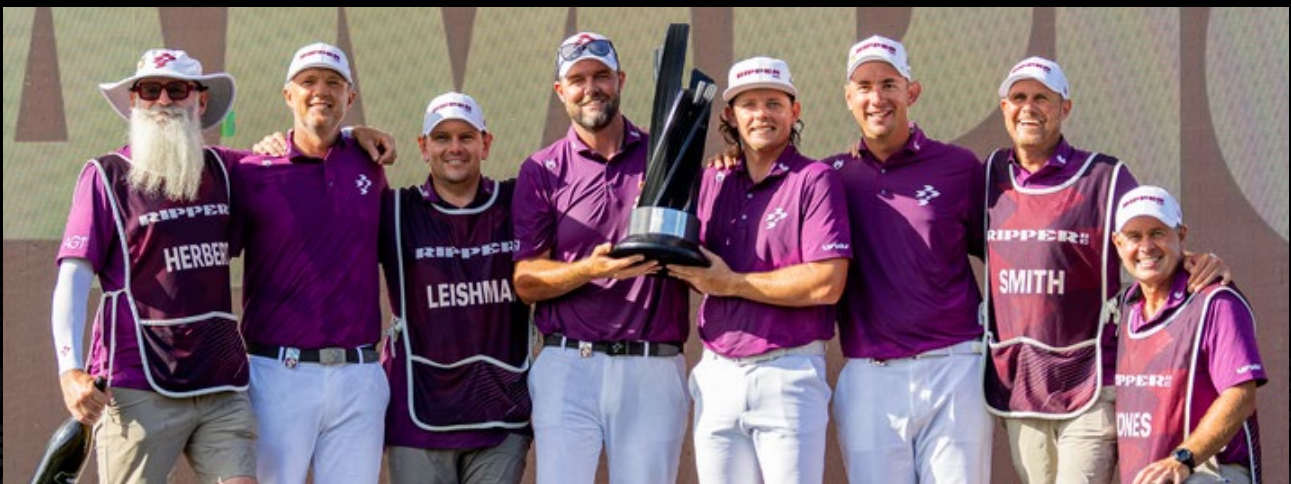


The Sunflower Program is an initiative that provides individuals with hidden disabilities—such as autism, anxiety, or chronic illnesses—with a discreet sunflower lanyard or badge, signaling to staff and others that they may need additional support, patience, or assistance. At LIV Golf, the program can enhance accessibility and inclusivity for spectators, players, and staff with hidden disabilities. By training event personnel to recognize the sunflower symbol, LIV Golf will ensure a more supportive experience, offering accommodations for those in need.



The Sensory Room, located in the main First-Aid tent, provides a relaxing and calming space for kids of all ages. This area promotes calmness and security by featuring soft bean bag chairs, soft flooring, a weighted blanket, and a soothing essential oil diffuser.

A light-up plush pillow adds gentle visual stimulation, while a selection of fidget toys offers tactile engagement for self-regulation. Designed for relaxation and quiet sensory exploration, this space helps children feel comfortable and at ease.
