TRAVELLING BY TRAIN

The closest National Rail station is Uttoxeter, however there are several larger stations in the area including Stoke-on-Trent, Burton upon Trent, Derby and Stafford. We recommend travelling via Derby or Stafford to avoid congestion, as these are the largest and most accessible stations in the area.

WHERE DO I ENTER?

Please refer to the **course map** to view the entrance.

ALL SPECTATORS ENTER VIA ENTRANCE B, LOCATED OFF STATION ROAD.

There are dedicated lanes for hospitality ticket holders.

ENTER & CARRY-IN POLICY

Guests are permitted to carry standard size backpacks measuring no larger than 40 litres, or 46-51 centimetres. There will be no storage offered for oversized bags.

No buckles, grommets/hardware or décor can be concealing any part of the bag.

Guests may bring food into the tournament for individual consumption in a clear, resealable plastic bag not to exceed the size of a (1) gallon bag. Apples, oranges, pears and other whole fruit must be cut in half.

One reusable plastic water cup/bottle per person that is empty or factory sealed, which cannot hold more than 32 oz / 1L is allowed.

Exceptions are made for Guests with medical needs and for glass baby bottles at the sole and absolute discretion of management.

Bags and their interiors will be visually inspected by security personnel at a screening table. Guests' belongings will be in their sight throughout the screening process, and Guests can pick up their belongings at the end of the table once they have completed the bag checks.

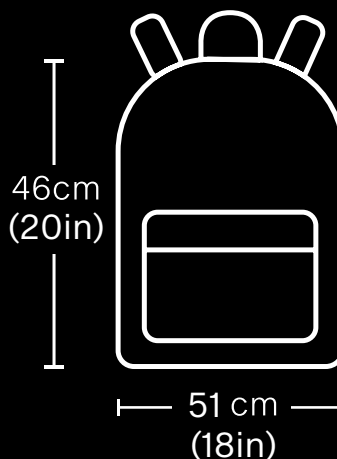
Medically necessary materials, mobility assistance devices, strollers, and small diaper bags are allowed

and are subject to search.

Any item that could affect the safety of the Tournament, its attendees, or property shall not be permitted onto the grounds. Any person that could affect the safety of the Tournament, its attendees or property shall be denied entry.

LIV Golf management reserves the right to prohibit or require the removal of any items at its sole and absolute discretion.

BAG POLICY



PROHIBITED ITEMS



Firearms, knives, electronic "stun" devices, chemicals, or other weapons of any kind (regardless of license or permit).



Briefcases, suitcases/luggage of any kind, or other hard-sided bags or containers.



Alcohol and illegal drugs or recreational drugs of any kind.



Drones, remote-controlled aircraft, or other unmanned devices.



Anything (including but not limited to, flags, flyers, banners, clothing etc.) that would facilitate ambush marketing or other commercial activity. No banners, boards, symbols, flyers, clothing, insignias, or propaganda-type material of an extreme religious, racist, or xenophobic nature or constituting an incitement to violence.



No bicycles, segways, scooters, skateboards, or other personal transportation devices (motorised or self-propelled) allowed inside admission gates (other than used for individuals with mobility disabilities or medical purposes)

Such items will be prohibited from being brought into the Tournament. There is no storage area for these items. Guests arriving by public transportation should take particular care not to bring any prohibited items, as no exceptions will be made.

PARKING & SHUTTLE INFORMATION

TRAVELLING BY CAR

We're expecting a big crowd at LIV Golf UK by JCB, so parking will be limited.

IF YOU'RE DRIVING, YOU MUST PURCHASE PARKING IN ADVANCE. IF YOU DON'T ALREADY HAVE A CAR PARK PASS, YOU CAN PURCHASE ONE [HERE](#).

THERE WILL BE PARKING RESTRICTIONS IN PLACE 1.5 MILES AROUND THE VENUE. TOW AWAY TRUCKS WILL BE OPERATION AND MAY TOW AWAY ILLEGALLY PARKED CARS.

It is only necessary to purchase one Car Park pass per vehicle per day. We advise car sharing to reduce the impact on the local road network.

BLUE TRIANGLE CAR PARK

Located at JCB Main Visitor Car Park in Rocester, Uttoxeter ST14 5JR.
The Blue Car Park is a 15-minute walk to Entrance B.

GREEN SQUARE CAR PARK (PARK & RIDE)

Available for purchase, located at Darley Moor, Ashbourne, Derbyshire, DE6 2ET. There are complimentary shuttles from the Green Car Park to Entrance B. This journey takes approximately 20 minutes. The drop-off location is a 5-minute walk from Entrance B. New for 2025, a portion of the park and ride shuttle fleet will be EVs.

TAXI AND RIDE-SHARE INFORMATION

TAXI AND UBER

- There is a dedicated Taxi and Uber drop off and pick up point.
- Please use the entrance off the B5030 (What3Words location) and follow signage on the road.
- The drop off point is a short walk to Entrance B.

SPECTATOR DROP OFF AND PICK UP

If you are dropping off or collecting friends and family please follow signs to the dedicated Pick Up / Drop Off location near the Blue Car Park (What3Words location).

ANY VEHICLE DROPPING OFF AND PICK UP ON THE PUBLIC HIGHWAY MAY RECEIVE A FIXED PENALTY NOTICE, AS THERE ARE TEMPORARY PARKING CONTROLS AROUND THE VENUE.

DRIVING DIRECTIONS – M1 / M6

To manage the flow of traffic for the event, guests TRAVELLING by car must exit the motorway from the following Junctions:

- **FROM THE M6 NORTH** – Exit on Junction 17 onto A534
- **FROM THE M6 SOUTH** – Exit on Junction 15 onto A50/A500
- **FROM THE M1 NORTH** – Exit on Junction 28 onto A38/A52
- **FROM THE M1 SOUTH** – Exit on Junction 24 onto A50/A515

FOR ALL ROUTES:

- Once you exit the motorway, follow black and yellow event signage for 'GOLF EVENT'.
- Then follow all signs for your pre-purchased Car Park: Blue Triangle, Red Circle, Pink Square (Blue Badge) or Green Square (Park & Ride).

STRICTLY NO OVERNIGHT PARKING.

GREEN CAR PARK - PARK & RIDE

- Located in: Darley Moor, Ashbourne, Derbyshire, DE6 2ET.
- There will be complimentary park and ride EV shuttles to Entrance B.
- Fans should allow 20 minutes for their journey to and from the venue.

BLUE CAR PARK - PREMIUM GENERAL ADMISSION

- Located in: JCB Main Visitor Car Park, Rocester, Uttoxeter, ST14 5JR.
- Fans should allow 15 minutes to walk to Entrance B.

RED CAR PARK - HOSPITALITY PARKING

- Located in: JCB Main Visitor Car Park, Rocester, Uttoxeter, ST14 5JR.
- Limited shuttles will be provided to Entrance B. Alternatively, fans should allow 15 minutes to walk to Entrance B.

PINK CAR PARK - BLUE BADGE ONLY

- Located off Stubwood Lane.
- Accessible shuttles will be provided to Entrance B.

SPECTATOR PICK UP & DROP OFF

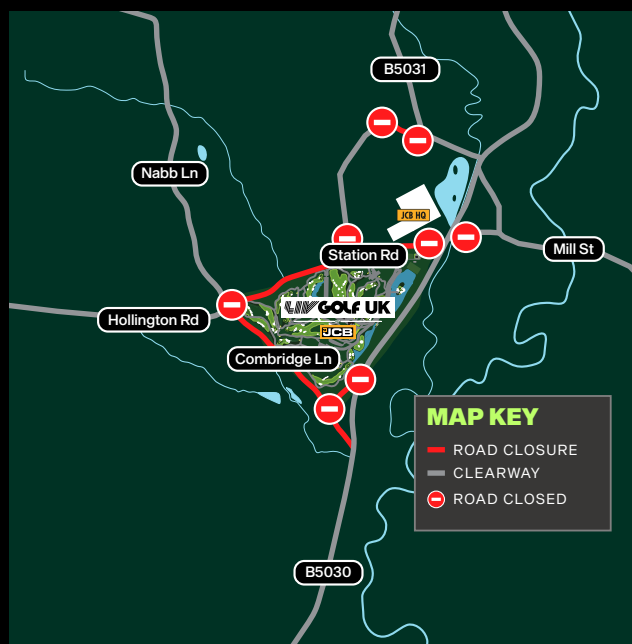
If you are dropping off or collecting friends and family please follow signs to the dedicated Pick Up / Drop Off located near the Blue Car Park.

IMPORTANT INFORMATION

WHERE IS LOST & FOUND?

- Lost & Found is located in Fan Services within the Fan Village. Please refer to the course map once available.

WHERE CAN I BUY MERCHANDISE AND WHAT ARE THE HOURS OF OPERATION?

- Official Merchandise is located in the Fan Village, adjacent to the 9th Green and 10th Tee. The shop will be open from 10:00am – 5:45pm. You can also purchase online [HERE](#).

CAN I BRING A WATER BOTTLE?

- One reusable plastic water cup or bottle per person that is empty upon entry and exit, which cannot hold more than 32 oz / 1 L is allowed, or one 32 oz / 1 L or less factory-sealed water bottle per person is allowed.
- There will be water stations throughout the course.
- No coolers, metal or glass bottles/cups of any kind are permitted unless medically necessary.

IMPACT & SUSTAINABILITY

Sustainability is a huge part of LIV Golf and this year at LIV Golf UK by JCB, we are stepping things up to protect the planet and support the local community. Here is how we are making this event cleaner, greener, and more responsible:

CLEAN ENERGY ON COURSE:

The Driving Range and Tees 3, 7 and 8 are powered by solar panels and batteries and all generators will run on 100% renewable HVO fuel.

ELECTRIC ALL THE WAY:

A fleet of electric buggies will be in operation and fans can make use of 15 EV charging points across and near the venue.

HYDRATE WITHOUT WASTE:

There are 24 free refill stations across the course - bring your own bottle and help eliminate single-use plastic.

SMARTER COURSE CARE:

The course uses a rainwater recycling system with 3,000 precision sprinklers - minimising water use while keeping conditions world-class.

ZERO WASTE GOAL:

We are aiming for zero waste to landfill. Bins are clearly labelled for recycling and compost and all materials are sorted and recovered.

STRUCTURE REUSE:

We are reusing 100% of our structures and 30% of our signage from 2024 - reducing waste and saving materials.

EV SHUTTLES & TRANSPORT:

We are cutting congestion and emissions by replacing some of our diesel shuttles with a fleet of electric vehicles. Over 10,000 fan journeys will be made using clean EV transport, with a small number also running between Derby Station and the course. By riding with us, you are helping to create a quieter, cleaner event for everyone.
