PROHIBITED ITEMS

Guests may bring one reusable metal or plastic water cup or bottle (maximum 32 oz / 1 litre), which must be empty when entering and leaving the venue.

Items used for ambush marketing or unauthorized commercial activity are not allowed. This includes (but is not limited to) flags, flyers, banners, or branded clothing.



Firearms, knives, electronic "stun" devices, chemicals, or other weapons of any kind (regardless of license or permit).



No bicycles, segways, scooters, skateboards, or other personal transportation devices (motorized or self-propelled) allowed inside admission gates (other than used for individuals with mobility disabilities or medical purposes).



Drones, remote-controlled aircraft, or other unmanned devices.



Anything (including but not limited to, flags, flyers, banners, clothing etc.) that would facilitate ambush marketing or other commercial activity. No banners, boards, symbols, flyers, clothing, insignias, or propaganda-type material of an extreme religious, racist, or xenophobic nature or constituting an incitement to violence.



Alcohol and illegal drugs or recreational drugs of any kind.



TV's, computers, laptops, or tablets to include wireless devices that emit radio waves (such as cell phone signal jammers, radio scanners and walkie talkies, wi-fi routers (wireless local networking devices), except for personal mobile phones and wireless receivers (such as radios).

PUBLIC TRANSPORT INFORMATION



We strongly encourage all ticket holders to use the free spectator shuttle buses and travel via the MTR. Spectator shuttle pick-up points are located at key locations across Hong Kong, including Central IFC, Quarry Bay MTR, Hung Hom MTR, Mong Kok, Kowloon Tong MTR and Sheung Shui MTR.

Entrances

All ticket holders will enter via the Main Fan Entrance, located between Fan Kam Road (粉錦公路) and Po Kin Road (保健路). At the Entrance, please follow directional signage for your ticket type.

Please refer to the course map once available to view the entrance location.

Public Shuttle Buses to LIV Golf

Free-to-board shuttle buses will be available on a first-come, first-served basis from multiple locations across Hong Kong Island, Kowloon, and the New Territories. Please check the prohibited items list before travelling, as security checks are in place and no storage facilities will be available on site. 

CAR PARKS A AND B – PASS HOLDERS ONLY

Please have your QR code ready for scanning upon arrival.

CAR PARK C – GENERAL PARKING

Available for all ticket holders. Guests should follow directional signage to the Public Car Park (Car Park C). Parking passes are not required.

ACCESSIBLE PARKING AND SHUTTLE

Accessible parking is available in Car Park A. Guests must present a valid Disabled Person's Parking Permit (DPPP) on arrival. Shuttle services will operate between the car park and the main entrance.

CAR PARK SHUTTLES

Complimentary shuttle services will operate from Car Park B and Car Park C to the Main Fan Entrance on a first-come, first-served basis. Vehicles will circulate continuously throughout the car park locations.

WATER STATIONS

Water refill stations are available throughout the course. Guests are encouraged to bring a reusable water bottle to stay hydrated and help reduce single-use plastics.

Guests may bring one reusable metal or plastic water cup or bottle (maximum 32 oz / 1 litre), which must be empty upon entry and exit. Refill stations are located at the Fan Village, Oasis, Hole 6 Green and Hole 12 Tee.

FAMILY SERVICES & ACCESSIBILITY



Hong Kong Golf Club features continuous cart paths to support accessibility for guests using wheelchairs. Designated accessible viewing areas are available at Hole 1 Tee, Hole 6 Green, Hole 11 Tee, Hole 18 Tee and Green, the Practice Range, and the Concert Area.

Free entry is available for children aged 12 and under with a grounds ticket purchase (one child per adult). For any hospitality area (including Grounds Plus), children ages 4 and older will need a ticket to gain access.

Only registered service animals are permitted at LIV Golf events.

LIV Golf Hong Kong is designed to be family-friendly and accessible throughout. A dedicated Family Services area is in the Fan Village, featuring changing stations, a private nursing area, and additional amenities to enhance the experience for parents and young children.

At LIV Golf Hong Kong, sustainability is more than a goal, it's built into every detail of the tournament.

70% WASTE DIVERSION GOAL

Help us hit our target by using the colour-coded recycling and composting bins located throughout the venue.

WATER REFILL STATIONS

Bring your own reusable bottle (subject to security) and refill at any of our 10 stations to help us eliminate single-use plastic.

CLEAN ENERGY

Our operations are powered by a 50% biodiesel blend, cutting CO2 emissions by up to 80% compared to standard fuel.

RE-USE FIRST CONSTRUCTION

From staging to flooring, we repurpose infrastructure from previous tournaments to minimise new production and waste.

LOCAL FLAVOUR

Experience the Greater Bay Area through our menus, featuring authentic Cantonese and Guangzhou-inspired flavours from local suppliers.

COMMUNITY LEGACY

Your attendance supports our work with local Hong Kong schools and nature programmes, including on-course biodiversity walks.

ACCESSIBLE FOR ALL

Our venue is designed for everyone, featuring accessible viewing areas, ramps, and dedicated shuttles to ensure all fans can move around the course comfortably.



SUSTAINABILITY & IMPACT CONTINUED

TRAVEL SMARTER

We're working to reduce the impact of travel wherever possible:

Spectator shuttles – Fans are encouraged to travel by public transport and complete their journey to Fanling via our spectator shuttle network, linking six major transport hubs and helping to minimise congestion and emissions.

PROTECTING THE COURSE

The golf courses at Fanling are home to a huge variety of birds, insects, reptiles, and other wildlife, many of which are rare, endangered and protected species. To protect this landscape:

- Heavy machinery routes are pre-mapped, and mats are laid to prevent turf damage.
- Electric machinery (i.e. forklifts and golf carts) are used whenever possible (instead of diesel or gasoline powered ones).
- Sensitive habitats are roped off and monitored.
- Mulch is added in high-footfall areas to protect roots and soil.
- By respecting the course, you're helping preserve it for the community and for nature long after the tournament.

SAVOUR BY LIV GOLF

Savour by LIV Golf is the culinary centrepiece of the Fan Village, bringing Hong Kong's food culture to the course. Three headline chefs deliver live demonstrations across Friday–Sunday, with samples distributed at each session. The activation blends local flavour, live cooking and DJ energy at the “Beats and Bites” stage.

ART + LIV GOLF + HKWALLS

FAN VILLAGE ACTIVATIONS

A Hong Kong-themed Kids Zone features a junk ship ball pit, STEM activities, VR putting and LEGO challenges.
