## PROHIBITED ITEMS

**PROHIBITED ITEMS include, but are not limited to:**



Firearms, knives, electronic "stun" devices, chemicals, or other weapons of any kind (regardless of license or permit).



No bicycles, segways, scooters, skateboards, or other personal transportation devices (motorized or self-propelled) allowed inside admission gates (other than used for individuals with mobility disabilities or medical purposes).



Drones, remote-controlled aircraft, or other unmanned devices.



Anything (including but not limited to, flags, flyers, banners, clothing etc.) that would facilitate ambush marketing or other commercial activity. No banners, boards, symbols, flyers, clothing, insignias, or propaganda-type material of an extreme religious, racist, or xenophobic nature or constituting an incitement to violence.



Alcohol and illegal drugs or recreational drugs of any kind.



TV's, computers, laptops, or tablets to include wireless devices that emit radio waves (such as cell phone signal jammers, radio scanners and walkie talkies, wi-fi routers (wireless local networking devices), except for personal mobile phones and wireless receivers (such as radios).



Guests are permitted to carry a clear bag in its natural state, such as a Ziploc gallon freezer bag, and/or an opaque bag. There will be no storage offered for oversized bags.

### FOOD AND WATER POLICY

Guests may bring food into the tournament for individual consumption in a clear, resealable plastic bag not to exceed the size of a (1) gallon bag.

Apples, oranges, pears and other whole fruit must be cut in half.

One reusable plastic water cup/bottle per person that is empty or factory sealed, which cannot hold more than 32 oz / 1 L is allowed.

## SHUTTLES

Accessible Shuttles will be provided from the lot to the main entrance.

## RIDESHARE AND TAXI DROPOFF/PICKUP

Located at USA Hockey Arena, 14900 Beck Rd, Plymouth, MI 48170 (Lot A).

This is available for fans and volunteers utilizing rideshares, taxis or being dropped off or picked up Friday through Sunday.

Shuttles will bring guests from Lot A to the Main Entrance.

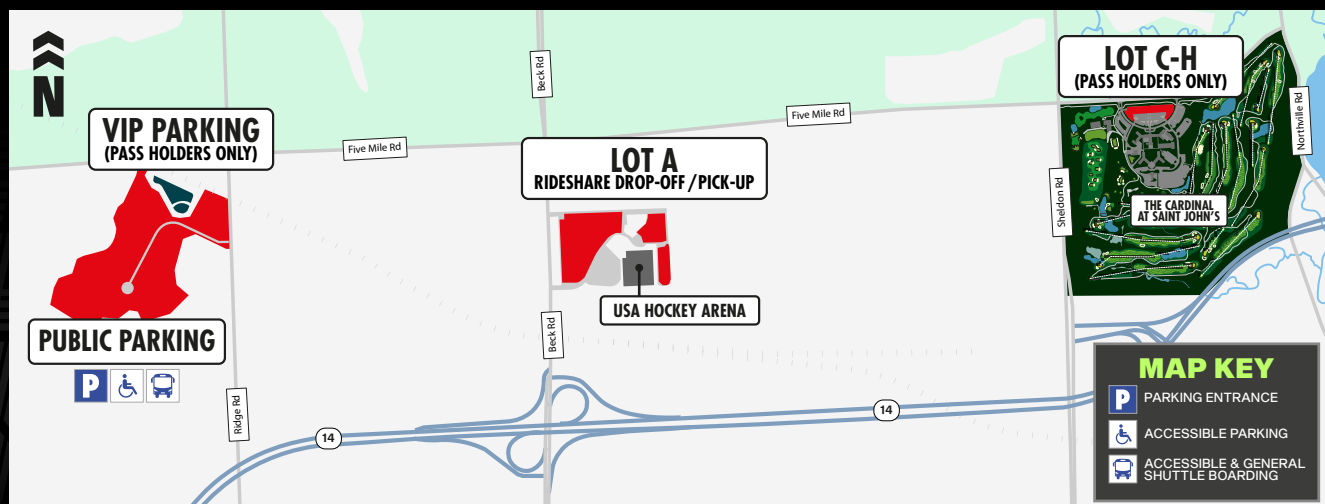

## OFFICIAL MERCHANDISE

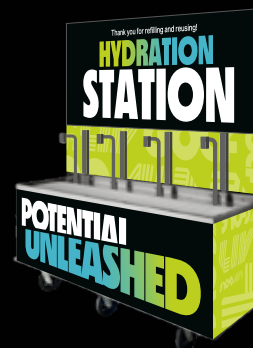

## HYDRATION

Water bottle refill stations are available throughout the course. Bring your own water bottle to stay hydrated and avoid single use plastics.

Guests may bring one reusable plastic water cup or bottle, no bigger than 32 oz or 1 liter, which must be empty upon entry and exit.

Saint John's Resort has continuous cart paths to provide easy access for those in wheelchairs. ADA viewing areas are available at the 1st Tee, 15th hole, and 18th Green.

LIV Golf Michigan is family friendly and accessible. Free entry for kids 12 years of age and under with a grounds ticket purchase (up to two kids per adult).

Only registered service animals are allowed at LIV Golf events.

# SUSTAINABILITY & IMPACT



At LIV Golf Michigan, sustainability is more than a goal, it's built into every detail of the tournament at The Cardinal at Saint John's.

- **70% waste diversion goal** – with a dedicated sorting team, composting through Midtown Composting, and specialist recycling for cables and mesh.
- **Surplus food donations** – meals and produce redirected to Forgotten Harvest, ensuring food supports families across Metro Detroit.
- **Reuse of materials** – construction materials donated to Habitat Oakland ReStore for community projects.
- **Clean energy** – 100% of light towers are solar powered, cutting emissions and noise on site.
- **Smart energy use** – generators are right-sized and run only when needed; six battery storage stations are also in use for broadcast.
- **Water refill stations** – eight refill points are located at 7 Green, between Holes 4 & 5, Hole 13, Hole 17, Fan Village, Family Fairway, and the stage. Bring your own reusable bottle (in line with security guidance)
- **Sustainable catering** – Club 54 features reusable serveware; concessions and Birdie Shack use BPI-certified compostables accepted locally.
- **Local flavour** – menus showcase Michigan-based producers, from artisan baked goods and sushi chefs to locally made snacks and pickles.
- **Plant-based choices** – Beyond Burgers and multiple vegetarian and vegan dishes are available across concessions and hospitality.
- **Accessible for all** – ADA-compliant viewing decks, ramps, elevators, shuttles, and restrooms make the event inclusive for every fan.
- **Community connection** – local schools, youth programs, and volunteer networks are actively engaged, helping grow the game and leave a positive legacy in Plymouth.

## Travel Smarter

We're reducing the impact of travel wherever possible:

- **Spectator shuttles** – parking is located 3.1 miles from the course, with shuttles running to and from the venue.
- **Public transport & rideshare** – fans are encouraged to use public transport or rideshare where possible, reducing congestion and emissions.
- **Active travel** – secure bike parking is available on-site, and walking routes are published for those nearby.

## Protecting the Course

The Cardinal at Saint John's is home to diverse wildlife including deer, turkeys, bluebirds, ducks, and hawks. To protect this landscape:

- Sensitive habitats are roped off and monitored.
- Heavy machinery routes are pre-mapped and mats are laid to prevent turf damage.
- Mulch is added in high-footfall areas to protect roots and soil.

By respecting the course, you're helping preserve it for the community and for nature long after the tournament.
