
All ticket holders, Park 'n' Ride – Free Shuttles to/from Toogood Reserve, Rideshare and Taxi

## PARK AND RIDE - TOOGOOD RESERVE

Access via Crittenden Road, Findon

Make use of the dedicated, free Park 'n' Ride service operating from Toogood Reserve (Adelaide 36ers Arena Car Park) on a first-come, first-served basis. Shuttles will transport guests to and from The Grange Golf Club Entrance D (public entry) on Trimmer Parade.

# RIDESHARE AND TAXI ACCESS



### Drop off only zones:

A dedicated 'drop off only zone' will be located on Frederick Rd (Gate C) and Trimmer Pde (Gate D) between 8:30am to 2:00 pm each day for patrons to access this event.

### Taxi ranks:

A dedicated taxi rank will be located on Frederick Rd (Gate C) and Trimmer Pde (Gate D) from 2:00pm to 9:00pm each day for patrons to access this event.



# PUBLIC TRANSPORT INFORMATION

## FREE PUBLIC TRANSPORT

Golf fans can catch FREE public transport across all 4 days with their valid LIV Golf Adelaide tickets. Free travel for LIV Golf is available on buses, trains and trams.

Regular Adelaide Metro bus services will continue to operate on Frederick Rd and Trimmer Pde during this event. Fans can take the bus directly to LIV Golf Adelaide on the following services:

The Glenelg-LIV Golf bus shuttle will operate across all 4 days of the event.

- At a high frequency between 8:30 am and 12:00 pm.
- Every 30 minutes between 1:00 pm and 3:00 pm.
- At a high frequency after play finishes and the concerts end.

#### SATURDAY

- At a high frequency between 10:30 am and 2:00 pm.
- Every 30 minutes between 1:00 pm and 3:00 pm.
- At a high frequency after play finishes and the concerts end.

This bus shuttle will service the following stops:

- STOP 19 ADELPHI TCE** – West Side
- STOP 17 MILITARY RD** – West Side

## PARK 'N' RIDE TO GATE D

Toogood Reserve - Trimmer Parade,  
The Grange Golf Club

The LIV Golf-Park 'n' Ride bus shuttle will operate across all 4 days of the event.

The shuttle bus will run:

- At a high frequency between 9:00 am and 1:00 pm Thursday, Friday and Sunday
- At a high frequency between 11:00 am and 1:00 pm Saturday
- Every 30 minutes between 1:00 pm and 3:00 pm Thursday and Friday
- Every 30 minutes between 1:00 pm and 4:00 pm Saturday and Sunday
- At a high frequency after play finishes and the concerts end.

This bus shuttle will service the following stops:

- **DESIGNATED BUS ZONE** - located at the Adelaide 36ers Arena on Crittenden Rd.
- **GATE D TRIMMER PDE** - at The Grange Golf Club.
- Patrons can park in **TOOGOOD RESERVE** located adjacent to the Adelaide 36ers Arena and transfer to the LIV Golf Park 'n' Ride bus shuttle service.

## TRAIN

Fans can catch the Outer Harbor or Port Dock line to Woodville Railway Station, then transfer to the Woodville-LIV Golf bus shuttle to The Grange Golf Club.

Patrons catching the Grange line can catch this service to:

1. East Grange Railway Station, a **22-MINUTE** walk to The Grange Golf Club
2. Seaton Park Railway Station, a **26-MINUTE** walk to The Grange Golf Club

## TRAM

Regular tram services will operate during the event, which fans can catch for FREE to the city or Glenelg and transfer to the City or Glenelg-LIV Golf Adelaide bus shuttles.

## PROHIBITED ITEMS

Prohibited items include but are not limited to:



Firearms, knives, electronic "stun" devices, chemicals, or other weapons of any kind (regardless of license or permit).



No bicycles, segways, scooters, skateboards, or other personal transportation devices (motorized or self-propelled) are allowed inside admission gates (other than used for individuals with mobility disabilities or medical purposes).



Drones, remote-controlled aircraft, or other unmanned devices.



Anything (including but not limited to, flags, flyers, banners, clothing etc.) that would facilitate ambush marketing or other commercial activity. No banners, boards, symbols, flyers, clothing, insignias, or propaganda-type material of an extreme religious, racist, or xenophobic nature or constituting an incitement to violence.



Alcohol and illegal drugs or recreational drugs of any kind.



TV's, computers, laptops, or tablets to include wireless devices that emit radio waves (such as cell phone signal jammers, radio scanners and walkie talkies, wi-fi routers (wireless local networking devices), except for personal mobile phones and wireless receivers (such as radios).



# ENTRY & CARRY-IN POLICY

# LOST & FOUND

Guests are permitted to carry standard size soft sided backpacks measuring no larger than 40 L, or 46-51 centimetres. There will be no storage offered for oversized bags.

Guests may bring food into the tournament for individual consumption in a clear, resealable plastic bag not to exceed the size of a 3 L bag. Apples, oranges, pears and other whole fruit must be cut in half. Outside beverages are not permitted.

One reusable plastic water cup/bottle per person that is empty or factory sealed, which cannot hold more than 1 L is allowed.

Only plastic refillable water bottles with a capacity of 1 L or under are permitted into the venue.

**NO METAL OR GLASS BOTTLES ARE ALLOWED.**
